Florida Association of Fire & Life Safety Educator of the Year

Nominations for the Florida Association of Fire and Life Safety Educator of the Year award are available to public educators who demonstrate excellence in using safety programs and materials to engage in their communities in consistent and creative ways during the prior calendar year. To determine the candidate's impact on the fire service and their award eligibility, nominations should include as much evidence and supporting documentation as possible in the following categories: Leadership, Community Engagement and Outreach, Establishment of Collaborative Partnerships and Networks, and Community Education and Innovation.

How nominees will be scored:

Nominations will be reviewed by an award committee. The award committee consists of current FFMIA/FAFLSE members and past "of the Year" award winners. The award committee will independently review each nomination. The committee will not be permitted to discuss the nominations or results with anyone. Nominees will be awarded up to four points in each of four categories with the highest possible score being 16 and lowest possible score being zero. Points will be awarded if they correspond to the demonstrated expectations for each criterion. Participants are eligible for points only if they meet all the specified expectations for each criterion (example below). In the event of a tie, the award committee will consider the nominees supporting documents, professional resume, and overall contributions to public education in the fire service.

Exceptional Evidence 4 Points

Exceptional level of detail regarding achievements and contributions in community engagement and outreach provided.

Achievements/contributions demonstrate the nominee consistently engages with the community to expand CRR efforts.

Strong Evidence 3 Points

Strong details regarding accomplishments or contributions for community engagement and outreach provided.

Achievements/contributions demonstrate the nominee occasionally engages with the community to expand CRR efforts.

Mominee has demonstrated effectiveness in collecting community feedback to evaluate the quality of programs and services.

^{*} In the example above, the nominee would qualify for "Strong Evidence" and be awarded 3 points since they met all the expectations under Strong Evidence.

- Advocates for the integration of risk reduction strategies into broader community planning and development initiatives.
- Demonstrates a commitment to CRR and has been recognized for professional efforts to integrate or expand CRR.

- Collaborate with community partners on joint initiatives, projects, and education programs to enhance collective risk reduction efforts.
- Facilitates regular meetings with CRR partners and communication channels to share information and coordinate responses to expand CRR into the community.
